PASTOR ARTHUR L. TURNER



Reverend Arthur L. Turner is a native of Gadsden, Alabama and comes from a lineage of Pastors. He accepted Christ at age eight at Bethlehem Baptist Church in Gadsden, Alabama. He remained active and spent much of his younger life singing in the youth choir, BTU and other church activities.

After relocating to Detroit, he later united with Second Canaan Missionary Baptist Church, where he served on the Deacon Board and was a member of the Male Chorus. After receiving the call into ministry, he was licensed on January 22, 1989 by Pastor Kelley and Second Canaan Missionary Baptist Church and served as an Associate Minister; and also an active in the Male Chorus and Sunday School Ministry. He was also an active member of the Fellowship District Associate Ministers and attended the National Baptist Congress of Christian Education.

In 1994, Reverend Turner joined Wayside Missionary Baptist Church and was ordained as a Minister of the Gospel in January 1955 by Reverend Doctor David N. Ford. While serving at Wayside, he expanded his preaching ministry and was afforded many opportunities to preach.

After moving to a new area, he united with Greater New Hope Missionary Baptist Church in New Haven, Michigan under the pastorate of Reverend John L. Mack. Pastor Mack recognized his zeal for the ministry and immediately began to utilize him in the ministry.

In October 2005, Reverend Turner returned to Wayside Missionary Baptist Church as an Associate Minister to assist Pastor Ford, whose health was failing. On June 11, 2006, he was installed as Pastor of Wayside following the death of Pastor Ford.

Reverend Turner expanded his ministry by taking classes at Tennessee School of Religion, William Tyndale College, and the Birmingham Bible Institute. He is actively involved in community services such as feeding the homeless and supporting AIDS awareness fundraisers. He retired from Daimler Chrysler after 33 years of service.

On October 10, 2009, Reverend Arthur L. Turner accepted the call as Pastor of New Bethlehem Missionary Baptist Church.

Reverend Turner is married to Elwanda Turner, who supports him in his ministry, and God has blessed them with two beautiful children, Tiffany and Rashad.
